★Japanese/English Curriculum

Activities are carried out mainly through themes and projects.

Focuses on creative expression, numeracy, literacy, as well as fostering social and emotional development.

The Japanese curriculum includes activities based on Japan's four seasons and culture, helping to build a sense of Japanese identity while nurturing respect and understanding of diversity.

★Corner Play (Learning Centers)

The classroom/shared areas are set up with themed activity corners.

By choosing and engaging in activities independently, children develop autonomy, concentration, and social skills.

★Hall Play

Children make use of the indoor hall facilities, allowing free activity regardless of weather conditions.

Encourages physical development such as flexibility and muscle strength, as well as growth in focus, patience, and cooperation.

★Outdoor Play / Gymnastics Play

Various outdoor activities are held in facilities within the Singapore National Stadium complex adjacent to the school.

Leveraging Iroha's fortunate location, these activities contribute not only to physical and emotional growth but also provide opportunities for diverse experiences of nature and society.

★ Nap Time [PN/N1]

We believe that sufficient rest is also essential for providing a safe and comfortable childcare environment. For this reason, nap time is scheduled for children in PN/N1.

For N1, nap time will gradually be shortened from around Term 3, as children begin to adjust to their daily routines.

From Term 4, nap time will be replaced by lesson time.

Every Monday, Tuesday, and Friday: Outdoor play (parks / commercial facilities, etc.)
Every Wednesday: Gymnastics class (in partnership with JACPA, held in the Iroha Hall)
Every Tuesday /Thursday : Sand play / Water play
